WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

The ASISA Academy's Collective Investment Schemes (CIS) Partnership Programme with the University of Johannesburg (UJ) offers employers and students an opportunity to participate in a specialist programme which prepares graduates to enter the CIS and investments industry. The course draws heavily on the expertise of multiple industry practitioners who present on specialist topics. The programme is primarily targeted at BCom (Investment Management) graduates but is open to graduates from any faculty where critical thinking, numeracy and problem solving are prized.

Companies looking to hire graduates into their CIS areas will pre-select students and sponsor their participation on the four week ASISA Academy work-readiness course. The graduates then commence a 12-month internships with their sponsors.
