WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT AND WHO IS IT FOR?

The internship provides high potential, early career black individuals with the opportunity to be part of a structured programme combining theoretical knowledge, work-readiness input, ongoing mentoring and practical work experience in established high-performing Independent Financial Advisor (IFA) practices.

Specifically the ASISA Academy is seeking applications from:

1. University graduates seeking career opportunities in the financial planning industry, based in Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban.
2. Established IFA practices, based in Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban, who have the capacity and energy to host interns for a 12-month period.



WHERE AND WHEN WILL IT BE OFFERED?

The internship will be offered in Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban commencing in the first quarter of 2018 with a 10-day work-readiness course from 14-28 February followed by a 12-month workplace internship in an IFA practice.



HOW IS THE PROGRAMME FUNDED?

This programme forms part of a broader IFA development programme being run by ASISA. A number of independent investment management firms are funding the work-readiness component and the majority portion of a monthly stipend to be paid to the interns. Host IFA practices will be expected to pay 30% of the monthly stipend.
